Within Board policy, the principal shall develop procedures for keeping school facilities safe and free from hazards. Each principal is responsible for seeing that the practice of safety is a part of the instructional program of the school and that it is appropriately geared to students at different grade levels.

The program shall include:

1. Fire prevention
2. Accident prevention
3. Warning systems
4. Emergency drills (Fire, severe weather, earthquake, and bomb threat)
5. Emergency closings
6. Traffic safety
7. Traffic and parking controls
8. Safety inspections
9. First aid
10. A disaster preparedness plan for a nuclear or other major emergency.

The principal shall secure assistance from law enforcement officials when the principal deems it necessary in order to maintain order or security during the school day or during extracurricular activities at school.
